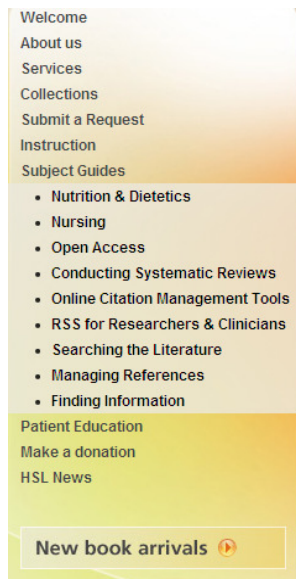
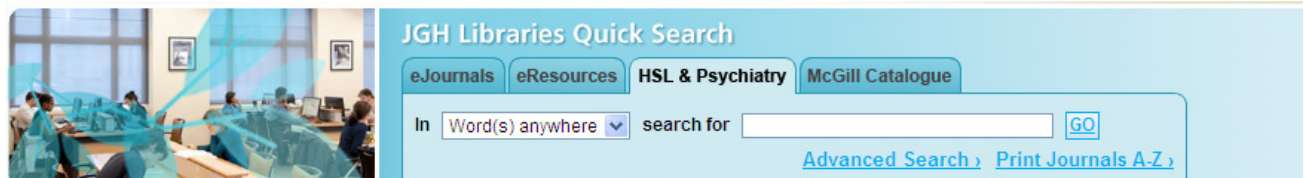


Health Sciences Library launches new website features

Starting this summer the following new features will make accessing print and online resources, and keeping up-to-date, easier than ever!

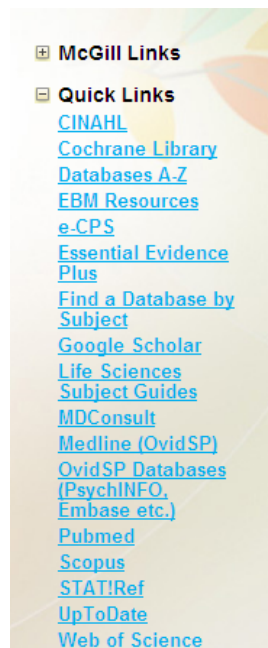


Quick search bar: Access our new JGH Libraries Quick Search Bar from any page on our library website to quickly find print and electronic resources in both JGH library collections (HSL & Psychiatry) and at McGill.

Side bar: On the right hand side of all library web pages you will find a sidebar that includes links to your most used online resources, and other McGill links. Quickly access EBM resources, electronic databases, McGill's subject guides, and more.

News bulletin: Our bulletins are now available as an RSS feed on our homepage. Click on the RSS icon to subscribe to our feed, or simply keep visiting our homepage, for announcements, information about new resources, new courses offered etc.
