The interventions of the Campagne québécoise has been divided between the three SIAs in the following manner:

Chantal Bellerose Dt.P, M.Sc. (cand) :

Falls - Prevent harm resulting from falls in long-term care settings

AMI– Acute Myocardial infarctus

SSI – Surgical site infection

VTE – Veneous Thromboembolism

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Paule Bernier Dt.P., M.Sc. :

CLI – Central line-Associated Bloodstream

RRT – Rapid response teams

ARO/MRSA – Antibiotic resistant organisms/Methicillin-resistant staphylococcus aureus

VAP – Ventilator associated pneumonia

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Caroline Robitaille BPharm., M.Sc. :

MedRec – Medication reconciliation (Acute Care)

MedRec – Medication reconciliation (Long term care)

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If you have any questions specific to a particular intervention, please contact the appropriate SIA responsible for the intervention.
